

LOCAL PROTOCOL

HIGH TEMPERATURES

- Do not expose yourself in the sun for long time – always use sun protection cream / lotion.
- Dress with light clothes and always carry water with you.
- Babies and elderly people are advised to carry an umbrella.

BEACHES

- Check weather forecast before entering the sea to ensure it is calm and safe for swimming.
- Nude bathing is prohibited.

LITTERING

- Littering is prohibited by law (penalty fees may apply).
- Recycle bins are available throughout the Hotel.

VISITING PLACES OF INTEREST

- Being a responsible member of the community is available.
- Information about places of cultural historical interest is available at the reception.
- Please, always respect archaeological, historical and religious monuments and places when visiting. Make sure you read the instructions before entering the area.
- Proper dress code (long trousers / skirts required) and donations are recommended when visiting places of spiritual and religious interests like churches and monasteries.

DRIVING AND TRANSPORT MEANS

- Driving license and insurance are always required.
- Minimum driving age is 18 years old.
- Always drive on the left side.
- Pedestrians – when crossing the road, remember that cars drive on the left side. First look right, then left, then right again. Cross only if the road is clear.
- Do not drink alcohol and drive – the alcohol limit is 18% (app. estimation: 2 glasses of beer).
- No bicycles or pedestrians are permitted on the motorway.
- Information about local transport and bicycle hire is available at the reception.

PROTECTION OF ANIMALS AND LOCAL FLORA

- Hurting or abusing animals is punished by law.
- Avoid sunscreens or soaps containing microplastics and other ingredients that harm biodiversity.
- The Hotel is actively involved in the protection of local flora such as sea lilies, on our preserved sand dunes, as well as wildlife such as bird nests, turtles, black snakes and lizards.
